COLO SPRGS, CO (March 20, 2021) – USA Shooting is happy to announce the final dates for the National Junior Olympic Rifle Championship at Hillsdale College in Hillsdale, Michigan, home of the USA Shooting National Team and sanctioned shooting sports development programs. Training and match days for both Smallbore and Air Rifle, Men and Women will occur May 12-16 at the Margot V. Biermann Athletic Center.

Through our partnership with Hillsdale College, we will be providing low cost housing and meal program options for competitors and their family members. Registration for the match and housing options will be launched in the coming days and competitors will receive an invitation to the match by email directing them to the registration portal.

The National Junior Olympic Pistol Championship will be held at a different location on different dates this year, more information to come later this year.
